

FOAC Presents Blue Oval Classic for 2011 Show Registration, Display and Judging

Registration and Classes:

The FOAC Blue Oval Classic is open to all makes and models made by Ford, Lincoln and Mercury. Street Rods, Hot Rods and other Custom Vehicles are also welcome, as long as they are Ford powered.

Please review the class registration sheet prior to registration to evaluate which class best suits your vehicle. If you are unsure which class to register in, please consult a show committee representative to help you make a proper choice. Please note that the judging committee reserves the right to change or reassign a vehicle to a different class.

How Vehicles Are Judged:

The judging is broken down into 4 categories:

- **Exterior:** Includes everything visible including paint, trim, weather-stripping, wheels and wheel wells.
- **Interior:** Includes everything visible in the passenger compartment including seats, door panels, carpet, headliner, dash, instruments. We also inspect door jambs, sills and door bottoms. NOTE: Please check the appropriate box on the "OK to Judge Sheet" granting or denying the judges permission to open your vehicles doors for inspection.
- **Under Hood:** Includes everything visible in the engine compartment including wiring, engine, paint, exhaust and hoses.
- **Trunk:** Includes everything visible in the trunk area including floor mat, spare tire, paint, and weather-stripping.

Each vehicle starts with a 100 point total. Judges will evaluate each vehicle based on overall appearance, cleanliness and neatness. Point deductions are then made in each area based on judges observations. Total deductions are then subtracted from 100 to obtain the final point score.

How to Display Your Vehicle:

- Windows rolled up
- Doors closed, Trunk open
 - Hood open
 - Convertible tops up
 - Floor mats removed
- Registration Card on the windshield or dash where best visible

A note on judging: The judges are all volunteers and car owners themselves. Their goal is to try and be as objective and fair as possible. It should be recognized that judging is not a science and is highly subjective. This means that on any given day the order of first, second or third place cars could be reversed. Or even a car that did not receive an award might place on another day. Please be courteous to the judges and help them as needed in judging your vehicle.
